Crown Indigenous Negotiations: Closing a Rift in Our National Fabric

Representatives of Indigenous groups have justifiably complained about the excessive amounts of time required to complete negotiations and the huge resource demands they place on communities where such resources are extremely scarce. Academics have focussed on the inequality of bargaining power and the limited options available to Indigenous parties. As a result, some Indigenous nations have simply refused to participate in Crown-developed negotiations processes.

The aim of the **Crown Indigenous Negotiations course** – offered as part of the Osgoode Professional LLM in Dispute Resolution in the Fall of 2022, and as an elective for the LLM in Constitutional Law or General Law – will be to expose students to the parameters and practice of key negotiations processes, especially the Comprehensive Claims Process (including the closely related British Columbia Claims process) and the Specific Claims Process. 
