Part-Time Studies | The program is designed to be completed in two years (six active terms) by completing 6 credits (one or two courses) per term.

Full-Time Studies | The program is designed to be completed in one year (three active terms) by completing 12 credits (two to four courses) per term. Full-time students usually take all their courses in person and are expected to visit campus on a regular basis.
