## Program Format

The Professional LLM in General Law requires completion of 36 credits including a research requirement. The program is designed to be completed in two years (six active terms) by completing 6 credits (one or two courses) per term. General students must declare two or three specializations from which they will take courses. While new students are admitted every Fall and Winter, some specializations may only be incorporated at specific times, according to when their required courses are held.

### Specializations with a Fall and/or Winter start:

- Administrative Law
- Business Law
- Canadian Common Law\*
- Constitutional Law
- Energy & Infrastructure Law
- Financial Law
- International Business Law
- Intellectual Property Law
- Privacy & Cybersecurity Law
- Securities Law

\*Only those with a law degree from outside Canada who are working toward accreditation can select Canadian Common Law.
